ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: In absence of the senior equipment operator, may operate a motor grader, bulldozer, and chemical spray truck; Operates equipment, machinery and tools used in construction, maintenance, and repair of county roads, bridges and drainage systems; Performs manual work functions associated with construction, maintenance, and repair of county roads, bridges, and drainage systems; Performs general maintenance tasks necessary to keep equipment/machinery in good working condition; Prepares and/or receives various forms, reports, or other documents; processes and forwards as appropriate; Communicates via telephone and/or two-way radio; responds to routine requests for information from officials, employees, the public, or other individuals; May perform general cleaning/housekeeping tasks associated with maintaining shop or other work areas; Performs other related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: One to two years of experience in equipment operation or a related field; or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience which provides the requisite knowledge, skills and abilities for this job. Must obtain and maintain a valid Alabama Class A or B Commercial Driver's License. (County may provide assistance in obtaining valid CDL upon employment)

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: Very heavy physical work demands.
