WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that this project is a necessary, eligible, and reasonable use of ARPA funds, including an expenditure to cover architectural/engineering services; and

WHEREAS, Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards as codified at 2 C.F.R. Part 200 ("Uniform Guidance") applies to the expenditure of ARPA funds, including procurement

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION as follows:

- 1) The Commission hereby authorizes the County Administrator to begin procuring design and construction services consistent with federal Uniform Guidance and state law to support this project.

- 3) No funds shall be expended without the Commission's prior approval of any contract resulting from the request for proposal process.
