WHEREAS, after the requisite public notice was provided, a public hearing was held on the 5th day of June 2023, regarding the permitting and use of lands owned by the City of Decatur and Morgan County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Decatur and Morgan County Commission recognizes that only ADEM can issue a permit for a Major Modification to Cap Cells 2-11; and

WHEREAS, the City County and Morgan County Commission has also considered the following:

1. The Settlement Agreement entered into the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of November 2021, by and between, on the one hand, 3M Company and, on the other hand, the City of Decatur, Alabama, a municipal corporation, Morgan County, Alabama, a body corporate, and the Municipal Utilities Board of Decatur, Morgan County, Alabama, referred to herein as Decatur Utilities. As part of the Settlement Agreement, The City of Decatur, Morgan County, and in Consultation with ADEM, have determined that Cells 2-11 at the Decatur Morgan County Landfill will be capped with a synthetic liner to reduce PFAS-containing leachate. The City of Decatur, through its contractor(s) to be selected through a public bidding process, shall conduct capping of Cells 2-11 in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations and with the approval of ADEM.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Morgan County Commission, Decatur, Alabama as follows:
