ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: Operates/drives a refuse packer truck and dump truck to collect refuse along a designated residential route and transports trash to landfill; Observes assigned route to provide collection service in compliance with departmental rules and regulations; Performs manual work functions associated with trash pickup and removal; Unloads garbage from truck at landfill site; Performs general maintenance tasks necessary to keep truck and equipment in good working condition; Communicates via two-way radio and/or telephone; responds to dispatch requests; provides information; relays messages and/or directs calls as appropriate; Represents the department in dealing with customers; Responds to routine requests for information from officials, employees, the general public or other individuals; Prepares and/or receives various forms, reports or other documents, processes and forwards as appropriate; Performs other duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: High school diploma or GED required; two years of experience in driving commercial class vehicles or a related field; or any equivalent combination of education, training and experience which provides the requisite knowledge, skills, and abilities for this job. Must possess and maintain a valid Alabama Commercial Driver's License. (County may provide assistance in obtaining valid CDL upon employment.)

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: Heavy physical work demands.
